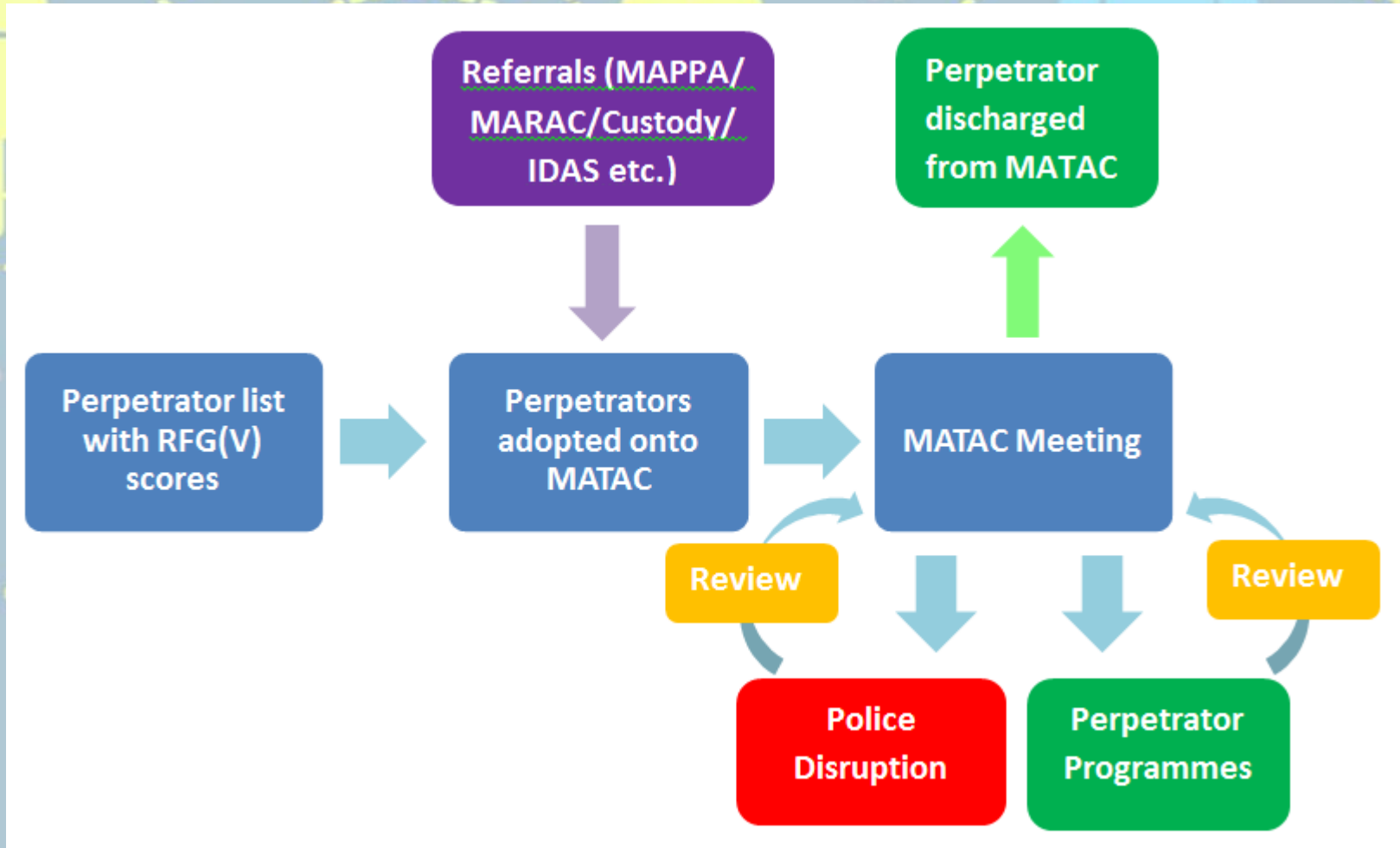

MATAC Process



Data, Analysis and Case selection

Raw data

- Domestic abuse data is obtained from the Performance Team.
- This includes crimes and incidents of Domestic abuse, where hate crime field contains 'Domestic' and there is a correctly linked perpetrator and victim*. This is supplemented by DV occurrences linked to DV flags.

Calculating individual scores

- RFG(V) - Recency, Frequency, Gravity and Victim score.
- Recency - how long ago was the last offence/incident. This is assigned a score and an average is taken for each perpetrator (max 100).
- Frequency - number of incidents in last 24 months gets assigned a score (max 200).
- Gravity - score is assigned depending on how serious the offence was (max 100).
- Victim - score is assigned depending on how many victims an perpetrator had (max 200).

Calculating the Harm Score

- All individual RFG(V) Scores are added up and divided by six to get the final score (max 100).

Pre selection

- 10 cases with the highest scores are selected.
- If there are commands that don't have any cases selected then the ones scoring highest in those commands are selected.
- Cases are then reviewed and considered for selection. This includes checking if they are already managed by another process e.g. MARAC and if that is sufficient.

Case selection

- Final selection is made by the MATAC Coordinator/Chair and the cases are passed onto the analyst to prepare a profile for the perpetrator before the meeting.

Perpetrator profiles

- Include details of the perpetrator and their victim(s), offending history and intelligence, flags and warning markers, orders in place, national and social media checks.

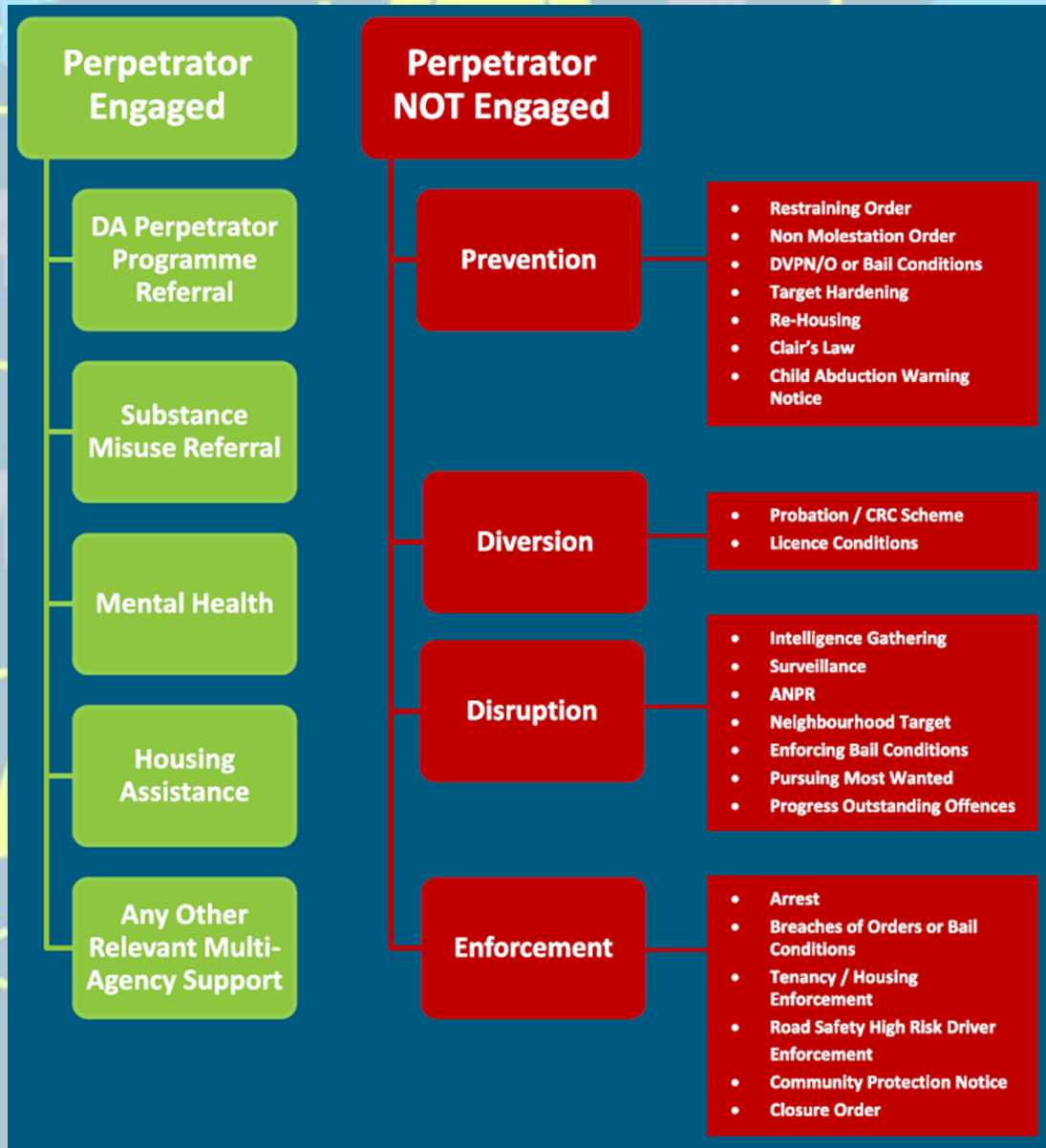

Perpetrator status



- **Live** – current cases being managed through the MATAC process using the toolkit.
- **Review** – each meeting will review previously heard live cases.
- **Archive** – those cases where the perpetrator has engaged and continues to engage with toolkit, options and opportunities. These can be reviewed if there are changes.
